ROSARY FOR THE FAMILY - Sunday June 19th via ZOOM

In preparation for the 10th World Meeting of Families, the CCCB Standing Committee for Family and Life is hosting a live and nationwide **Rosary for the Family** via Zoom Webinar. The event will take place on **Sunday, 19 June 2022 at 3:00 p.m.** (EDT) facilitated by several families from across the country.

As part of the *Amoris Laetitia* Family Year, the Pope's Worldwide Prayer Network and the Dicastery for the Laity, Family and Life have published a "Rosary for the Family." The publication is a beautiful meditation focused on families, children, couples and grandparents. It is the hope of the Standing Committee for Family and Life that this moment will be an opportunity to gather at the national level in prayer as well as to witness alongside other faith-filled families.

They were all filled with the Holy Spirit. (Acts 2:4)

No one who was gathered in the upper room on Pentecost could have missed the presence of the Holy Spirit. A strong, driving wind, tongues of fire, and the apostles speaking in different languages: it was clear that Jesus' promise of the Spirit coming upon them had been fulfilled (John 14:16).

But that promise wasn't just for the apostles long ago: it's for us today as well.

So let's take the opportunity on this great feast to pray for a greater outpouring of the Spirit in our lives.

"Holy Spirit, You appeared as tongues of fire. I want the fire of Your love to burn in my heart. Give me a love that never grows cold, along with the zeal to spread Your saving message to all whom I encounter each day.

"Holy Spirit, You gave gifts to the disciples to build Your Church. In order to do Your work, I need gifts that can only come from You—gifts of wisdom, understanding, counsel, and strength; gifts of prophecy, healing, and discernment of spirits (Isaiah 11:2; 1 Corinthians 12:7-10).

You know that I am asking for these gifts not just for myself but so that I can also bring You glory and lead other people to You. In this season of my life, I especially ask for the gift of _____.

But whatever you want to give me, I am open to receiving it.

"Holy Spirit, You opened Peter's ears so that he could hear the message You wanted him to preach. Open my ears too so that I am able to hear you. I want to be Your instrument—to act on whatever You are urging me to do. I can't do that without staying attuned to Your voice, so help me to listen to You over the noise and busyness of each day.

"Holy Spirit, as You did with the disciples on Pentecost, empower Your people today.

Together may we preach the good news and build Your kingdom on earth!"

"Come, Holy Spirit, and fill me with Your love, Your grace, and Your gifts."
