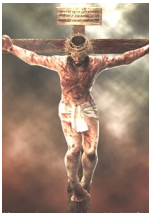

**Easter Triduum—Holy Thursday** is the remembrance of the Last Supper of Jesus, when He established the sacrament of Holy Communion prior to His arrest and crucifixion. It also commemorates His institution of the priesthood. Christ washed the feet of his disciples, an act of humility and service. During the Mass, Catholics rightly believe, as an article of faith, that the unleavened bread and wine are transformed into the body and blood of Jesus Christ through a process known as transubstantiation.



**Good Friday** is the day on which Catholics commemorate the Crucifixion of Jesus. It is a day of fasting within the Church. Traditionally, there is no Mass and no celebration of the Eucharist. A liturgy may still be performed, and communion comes from hosts consecrated on Holy Thursday. The Church - stripped of its ornaments, the altar bare, and with the door of the empty tabernacle standing open - is as if in mourning. It is appropriate to observe a period of silence at home, for devotional reading and private prayer (e.g., no music, television, etc.), especially between the hours of noon and 3 o'clock in the afternoon.



**Easter Vigil** liturgy is the most beautiful liturgy in the Roman Catholic Church. Celebrated Holy Saturday evening, it is the dramatic Easter vigil liturgy that marks the beginning of Easter. The vigil is divided into four parts:



**1. Service of Light** - The atmosphere in the church is different: the holy water fonts are drained, all the lights are out, the tabernacle is empty. The service may begin outside the church. A new fire is lit and blessed. Everyone lights their candle from the Easter candle until the whole church is alight. The Paschal candle symbolizes Christ, the Light of the World.

**2. Liturgy of the Word**— 9 readings are provided: 7 Old Testament and 2 New Testament. Not all need to be read but at least 3 Old Testament readings must be read, including Exodus 14.



These readings help us meditate on the wonderful works of God for his people since the beginning of time.

**3. Liturgy of Baptism**- During this time the Easter water is blessed, new members are brought into the Church through baptism, part of the liturgy includes the Litany of the Saints. Afterwards the faithful are blessed with water and all renew their baptismal promises.



**4. Liturgy of the Eucharist**- So resumes the Mass, with the special prayers inserted during the Eucharist Prayer. The whole church is called to join at the sacrificial table that Christ prepared for us through his death and resurrection. The Mass ends with the glorious Alleluia!!



**Easter Sunday** is the celebration of Christ's resurrection from the dead. His resurrection marks the triumph of good over evil, sin and death. It is the singular event which proves that those who trust in God and accept Christ will be raised from the dead. Since Easter represents the fulfillment of God's promises to mankind, it is the most important holiday on the Christian calendar.

The annual **Good Friday Collection** helps the **Church of the Holy Land** to maintain Christian sites, so important for Christians everywhere, and to provide pastoral, educational, and social works. **Please give generously during your parish's Good Friday celebrations on April 18.** If you are unable to attend the service, it is possible to contribute
